### General: Notes for JAY HASKINS LAUTZENHEISER:

The plot that Jay is buried in was owned by Mary Ellen Lautzenheiser Knowlton, Jay's older half sister. Also in this plot is Henry B. and wife Harriett E. Lautzenheiser, Ellen's husband Jas. L. and two daughters Ida O. Knowlton, and Kate Knowlton Tyler and her husband Samuel M. Tyler. The ashes of Kate and Samuel share the same site as Jay's body. This is why they had to get special permission from Samuel to bury Jay in that site. Frank Lautzenheiser's ashes are at the foot of Harriett's grave. Jay was married to Nellie Billings. To them were born the four sons, Henry, Pete, Ruck, and Robert. Jay met another woman named Alice Savage. Jay and Nellie separated and Jay and Alice married. Neither Jay or Nellie wanted the boys, so Cora Billings (Nellie's mother) raised Pete, Ruck and Robert in MI. behind

St. Anthony's Church on Rt. 223. Henry was sent to live with Jay's sister, Gertrude Lautzenheiser Beardsly in Knoxville, TN. Cora actually took them out of the Maumee Childrens Home after the (1920 census) so they could be together. Jay as a young man worked on the pickle farms in the Maumee area. He later worked in a hat factory. According to the 1920 census Jay and brother Frank were living with their mother, Harriett Elizabeth Haskins Lautzenheiser, age 79.
